

Les Compagnons Réunis are specialized in the restoration of historic buildings and listed monuments.

Their craftsmanship has brought many parts of the estate back to life. We are truly in awe of the incredible work they've done—not only on the chapel, but also on the nymphaeum.

Over 9 months of work, 30 tonnes of stone were replaced, and around fifteen sculptures were restored, representing nearly fifty hours of skilled labor.
